

# Great Yarmouth Festival Beers May 2017

## Adnams

Free Wheel 3.6%

Adnams Freewheel is a straw-coloured English summer ale with aromas of citrus and peaches, beautifully balanced by a touch of gooseberry on the finish.

Ghost Ship 4.5%

Pale Ale has a good assertive pithy bitterness and a malty backbone. It is brewed with a selection of malts – Pale Ale, Rye and Cara – we use Citra, and a blend of other American hop varieties to create some great citrus flavours.

## All Day Brewing

Big Barn IPA 5.5%

"A blond-style IPA that features Cascade hops, delivering signature floral, slightly spicy, and grapefruit-citrus flavour notes as well as a relatively low alpha acid range for optimal refreshment.

Nelson Stag Beetle 4.4%

An easy-drinking amber ale bittered with Norfolk-grown Fuggles but also showcasing a late addition of rare, imported, fruity Nelson Sauvin hops.

Norfolk Green Hop 4.3%

Amber in colour, fairly light bodied – a little bit like us out in the hop garden over the summer, in fact...

Norfolk Yeah 3.7%

Delivering delicate floral, fresh, grapefruit-zesty flavour notes. The Crisp Malting Group's distinctive 'pale ale' and Cara Gold malts that also feature provide a sweet, malty balance.

## Cameron's Brewery

Roots and Fruits 4.1%

Wonderful fruity pale ale infused with blueberry and ginger to give a spicy finish.

## Cliff Quay Brewery

Cliff Quay Bitter 3.4%

Amber coloured, Classic session beer.

Sea Dog 5.5%

The strong pale ale from citrus aroma fruity and full flavoured.

Tumble Home 4.7%

Full flavoured, malty ruby ale.

## **Earl Soham Brewery**

### **Albert Ale**

4.4%

A dark chestnut, full flavoured malty ale.

### **Brandeston Gold**

4.5%

A burnished gold ale, with a fruity malt flavour.

### **Sir Rogers Porter**

4.2%

Dark, roasted malt flavoured porter.

### **Victoria**

3.6%

The old favourite from Earl Soham a light coloured malty bitter.

## **Grafton Brewery**

### **Framboise**

4%

Pale yellow ale with a hint of raspberry on the palate.

### **Priors Well Ale**

4%

Pale session bitter with a glorious finish on the palate.

## **Green Jack**

### **Golden Best**

3.8%

Golden Best has a light floral aroma, clean and crisp with a slightly dry finish.

### **Lurcher Shout**

4.8%

Lurcher is a rich smooth stout, a roasty dark ale with mature blackcurrant in the aroma and a fruity hoppy bitterness in the taste, quickly giving way to a long sweetish aftertaste.

### **Rising Sun**

4.8%

Rising sun is a refreshing pint, clean and crisp with a fruity yet spicy hop character and aroma.

## **Hanlon's Brewery**

### **Firefly Bitter**

3.7%

Crisp amber session bitter. Firefly has a clean and citrusy finish and is late hopped with Saaz.

## **Lacons**

### **Encore**

3.8%

Light amber, packed with a smooth citrus punch. Balanced dry pine and zesty flavour throughout that finishes with a robust long bitterness.

### **Legacy**

4.4%

\*Bronze - Best Bitter - SIBA East Festival 15\* Light blonde, deep flavour. Lemon and lime battles the palate. Lengthy mellowed finish.

### **Light Mild**

3.7%

Dark amber ale packed with underlying fruity flavours and a glorious nutty taste.

## **Panther Brewery**

### **American Pale Ale**

4.4%

A thirst quenching beer. Late hopped using the finest Chinook, Centennial and Equinox hops for an aromatic tropical and citrus flavour

### **Black Panther**

4.5%

A dark rich Ale with a complex full flavour. Bittersweet balance that leads to a dry finish

### **Red Panther**

4.1%

An intense red ale with a roasted nutty flavour, deliciously clean and toasty

## **Rudgate Brewery**

### **Mango in the Night**

4%

Mango and citrus A fruit-filled nose with a hop-infused pale ale.

## **St Peters Brewery**

### **EPA**

3.8%

An English Pale Ale with a robust bitterness from using 100% Goldings hops at 4 stages of the brewing process. This results in a golden clean tasting and relatively dry beer. A great session beer.

### **Golden Arrow**

4.2%

Rich gold in colour. A moreish, sweet malt finish with spicy and citrus notes.

### **Mild**

3.7%

Sweetness balanced by roasted Black and chocolate malts to produce a rare but much sought after traditional Mild.

## **Tombstone Brewery**

**Santa Fe** 5%

Sweet fruity flavour with a twist of cinnamon.

**Six Shooter** 6.6%

Golden Strong full fruity flavour with a hint of caramel.

**Stagecoach** 4.4%

Smooth malty caramel with an underlying notes of liquorice.

**Tombstone** 3.7%

Fresh and zesty, brewed with fresh lemons and orange.

## **Wolf Brewery**

**Battle of Britain** 3.9%

A British best bitter, copper in colour this ale has lots of bite. English hops Goldings and challenger combined makes this a glorious full bodied brew. A donation by the brewery is made on each sale to the RAFA "Wings" appeal.

**Lavender Honey** 3.8%

Honey from Norfolk is infused during the brewing process to give this beer a delicate yet moreish flavour.

**Mad Wolf** 4.7%

A smooth malty dark ale with a taste that makes you crave for more.

**Wolf Whiskers** 4.4%

A dark rich ale with a fruity aroma.

## **Woodforde's Brewery**

**Flagondry** 3.6%

A highly aromatic and easy drinking 3.6% amber ale, brewed with Maris Otter malted barley blended with the finest Norfolk honey.

**Once Bittern** 4%

A copper-coloured ale with a distinctive aroma of rich spice and citrus fruit. Hints of sweet malt and fruit with a dry finish.
