American Pale	4.4	Late hopped using the finest Chinook, Centennial and Ekuanot hops for an aromatic, tropical and citrus flavour
Winter Porter	5	Rich, dark, fruity mysterious full flavoured ale. Flavour of chocolate, smoke, berry and coffee with a low bitterness
Winter's Brewery		Norwich, Norfolk
Evolution APA	4	Four types of American Hops. Tropical fruit aromas dominate the nose with lemon and grapefruit filling the palette
Cloud Burst	3.7	Chestnut coloured ale, combining maris otter pale and crystal malts with a balance of styrian hops.
Lacons		Great Yarmouth, Norfolk
Encore	3.8	Light blonde ale, deep with flavour. Lemon and lime bates the palate to a lengthy mellowed finish.
Patriot		Full bodied session ale carries dominant tropical fruit/berries in aroma followed by tart citrus on the palate

E.P.	3.5	Super crisp extra pale ale with Citra hops. Expect grapefruit, gooseberry and Lychee notes.
Session	4	NZ hopped bitter, traditionally british in style with flavours of grapefruit and orange zest promnents.

Sloe Storm	4	Red winter ale brewed with sloes to give a lovely red fruit aroma with notes of raisins and dates.
White Lies	4.5	pale gold white porter with aromas and flavours of chocolate, tropical fruit from the hops, and brioche
Old Ale	4.1	Traditionally styled ale is predominately dry with a malty base and slight undertones of cherries and plum
